1.) **Suspension during Team 1's innings.**

In a 50-overs innings Team 1 reach 79 for 3 after 20 overs and then there is a suspension in play. It is decided that 20 overs of the match should be lost. 10 of these by each team. Team 1 resume to reach a total of 180 in their revised allocation of 40 overs.

What is the target score for Team 2, assuming they will receive their allocation of 40 overs?

2.) **Delay to start of Team 2's innings.**

Team 1 score 200 in their allocated 40overs. Rain then causes Team 2's response to be delayed and it is decided that it should be shortened to 30 overs. What is the target score for Team 2?

3.) **Suspension during Team 2's innings.**

Team 1 have scored 250 from their allocation of 50 overs in an uninterrupted innings. Team 2 have received 12 overs and scored 40 for 1. Then play is suspended and 10 overs are lost.

At the re-start, what is Team 2's target score?

4.) **Multiple suspensions and abandonment**

Suppose that in example 3, play continues for a further 10 overs during which Team 2 take their score on to 98 for 3, whereupon there is another suspension in play and 2 more overs are lost. A further 8.2 overs are bowled and Team 2 are 154 for 6 when rain washes out the match. Who is the winner and how is it recorded?

5.) **Suspension and termination of Team 1's innings mid-over and delay to Team 2's innings.**

Team 1 scored 226 for 8 in 47.1 of scheduled 50 overs. Rain then terminates Team 1's innings and delays Team 2's which is given a reduced allocation of 33 overs. What is the target score for Team 2?

6.) (a) In a 50-overs match rain interrupts the first innings after 21.2 overs. Team 1's score at this stage is 112 for 3 wickets. Overs left = 28.4. Play resumes with a delay that causes both teams to lose 5 overs. Play resumes with 23.4 overs left to bowl. Rain again interrupts play after 35.4 overs have been bowled, leaving 9.2 overs left. Team 1's score at this stage is 190 for 5 wickets. Play resumes with 7.2 overs left to bowl. Team 1's final score is 246 for 8 wickets from 43 overs. What is Team 2's target score before the second innings starts?

(b) Rain interrupts the second innings after 22.4 overs have been bowled. Team 2's score is 106 for 4 wickets. Rain interruption causes the loss of 6 overs. Play resumes and there are no further interruptions in play. What score does Team 2 need to make to win the match?
