

Major Changes to TDCA Playing Conditions across all Divisions

- A team must have at least **Nine (9)** players dressed in cricket attire in the presence of the umpire prior to the toss. A plea that **Nine (9)** dressed players were present at an earlier time but have now departed will be ineffective.
- No substitute allowed for late coming players for any reason.
- any bowl going outside leg - called wide
- No Spikes (Metal/Plastic) allowed anywhere on the field of play except when playing on turf.
